# 3 Positions available in school currently:

### **Governors and Leadership Team**

We are currently in the midst of school assessments and statutory testing. Statutorily we have to provide assessments for Reception Early Years Foundation Stage outcomes, Year I phonics, Year 2 and Year 6 SATs in Maths, reading, writing and Science and additionally Year 6 in spelling, grammar and punctuation. Parents of children in these year groups will receive formal communications about these results by the end of term. We are currently collaborating with the local authority and other schools to moderate our findings to ensure that all children are assessed in the same way to the same standards in all schools.
