Year I and 2 Trip to Plymouth

Years I and 2 will be going on an educational visit to Plymouth Hoe and Plymouth Theatre Royal on **Tuesday 18th January (Dove)** and **Wednesday the 19**th (Lime and Beech). The visit is linked to our current Geography topic and is a perfect opportunity to experience spending time within a city environment different to our school town of Totnes! The children will be watching the show 'The Man Who Wanted to be a Penguin' at the Theatre Royal in the morning and then walking from the theatre along the Hoe and to the Barbican area.

Reception and Year | New Phonics Scheme Little Wandle Letters and Sounds



We have purchased a new Systematic, Synthetic Phonics scheme which is called Little Wandle. This scheme will help us achieve our ambition that all children will leave KSI being able to read.

The key difference you will notice as Reception and Year I parents is that quantity of books that your child brings home will be less but the fluency and confidence in your child will be increased. To ensure that reading at home is an enjoyable experience and does not feel like a chore we will be sending reading practice in which your child can read 95% of the words. This book has been carefully matched to your child's current reading level. Please don't worry that it's too easy – your child needs to develop fluency and confidence in reading. Your role will be to listen to them read the book. Remember to give them lots of praise – celebrate their success! If they can't read a word, read it to them. After they have finished, talk about the book together.

In addition to the Reading Practice book your child will bring home a Sharing Book. In order to encourage your child to become a lifelong reader, it is important that they learn to read for pleasure. The sharing book is a book they have chosen for you to enjoy together.

Please remember that you shouldn't expect your child to read this alone. Read it to or with them. Discuss the pictures, enjoy the story, predict what might happen next, use different voices for the characters, explore the facts in a non-fiction book. The main thing is that you have fun!


