After school

All children playing on the field after 3.15 need to be supervised by an adult. We have had some complaints from some parents about children's behaviour on the field and we are sorry to hear about this but children are solely parent's responsibility after 3.15pm once they have been collected or left the school building having been given permission from their parents to walk home alone (We do advise no younger than Year 5/6). If you have given permission to your child to walk home then they should leave the school premises immediately and walk straight home, not play on the field unaccompanied. If you are supervising your child after school until the gates close at 3:30pm then please ensure they are behaving well within our school rules. Particularly, the children know to stay off the flower and vegetable beds and stay off the grass on the grass bank as the foot fall is killing our greenery.

We are in need of raffle prizes. If you work for a company or own a company who could donate something, we would really appreciate anything you could offer. Thank you to those who have already donated.


Praise Assemblies
