
Dear Parents and Carers,

Last day of term is this Friday and it is Mufti Day – Please give us a donation (£1 is recommended) for our PTA. First day back is Monday 2^{nd} November.

Parent Evening bookings

Parent evenings (consultations) will be on the two consecutive Mondays - 9th November and 16th November. The booking system requires us to have 4 different booking forms – two for each date as Reception's appointments are slightly longer than the rest of the school and needed a different booking form.

At 2pm today eSchools will send you an email telling you that the bookings system is available. You can use the link on the email or use the website http://www.the-grove-primary.devon.sch.uk/web. You will have to sign in using your username and password. See the image below.



If you have forgotten your username and password put your email address in the email address section and then click on the l've forgotten my password text at the bottom of the screen in blue.

You can only book one session per child. We do hope that separated parents can manage a joint zoom meeting but if this is completely impossible please let us know.

The appointments are 8 minutes long (10 mins with reception children) with a 2 minute turn around time so we will have to be prompt. As there are two dates available and 2 different booking forms for Reception, and the

rest of the school - please check the date carefully when booking as you will get a notification email for each date.

On the day of your appointment you will be sent a zoom invitation from the class teacher. There will be a zoom waiting room system. If you can't manage zoom then also please book a time slot anyway and then let us know and we will arrange a telephone appointment at your allotted time.

Fingers crossed this will all work smoothly but if there are some hiccups please be patient and kind with us as we have never done this before!!
