Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome to a new school year at The Grove, all the children and staff are all settling very quickly and smiles are filling the school. Please do let us know if your child has any wobbles though and we will do our best to address them as quickly as possible.

Parking

South Hams District Council sell Resident Parking Permits which allow you to park in car parks operated by South Hams District Council (except Dartmouth Park and Ride car park). You can park seven days a week, between the hours of 3.00pm and 10.00am. They cost £40 and are available online or from Follaton House. Please try to use these facilities rather than parking on The Grove or Grove Mews. We have found that parking on the yellow lines can be very dangerous. It is also annoying our neighbours so if you can please try to use the Heath Way entrance and park in the car parks or better still walk in. Please also be warned that we are told that traffic wardens will be monitoring The Grove closely due to the problems that have arisen. If you need to use the disabled access parking for our school, please phone ahead for Rebecca to remove the chain. Many thanks for your understanding on this matter.

Safeguarding and Security at The Grove School for New Parents

The entrance at Heath Way will only be open from 8.45 -9.15 and 3.10 -3.30 and closed for the rest of the school day. Any parents, carers or visitors needing to come into school will need to use the front/main entrance (double glass doors). This avoids visitors making the long walk past the children in the playground and in their classrooms Also all children and parents are to be off site by 3:30pm unless in a club or attending Orchard club. Playing on the field and climbing frames is reserved for KS2 children only in the morning before school.

<u>NUTS!</u>

<u>PLEASE NO NUTS IN SCHOOL –</u> due to some severe allergies in school we have been a no nuts school for some time now. We have children with allergies in both key stages so we need to be careful on the playground and in the dinner hall at all times. Please check the packaging for nut information. Packaged in a factory that handles nuts is okay so long as actual nuts aren't part of the ingredient list. Thank you for your understanding on this matter.

Uniform, Coats, Lunch boxes, Trainers, Bags etc

We seem to collect a lot of lost property. Please could you label all your children's belongings so that when we find something we can return it. This also helps with other children's clothes being taken home by the wrong person.

Year 6 residential - change of date

We apologise for any difficulties caused but the centre we attend unfortunately made an error and booked us in for the week ending in Good Friday. For the Year 6 children to attend a full week of residential and not freeze we have opted for an alternative week beginning I3th November. We realise that this is much shorter notice for payments to be made and if you may struggle with this then please let us know and we can arrange a payment plan. We also are aware that fundraising usually reduces the cost of this trip for parents so we are still planning to fundraise and offer a refund at the end of the school year based on monies raised. The good side is that the trip is always a tremendous success in building confidence and closer relationships within the class so for this to happen earlier will actually be very beneficial. Thank you for your understanding on this matter, more details will follow shortly.


