Scam calls to parents and carers

A primary school has reported an incident where a parent has received a scam phone call from an unrecognised number requesting payment for an Anti-Bullying book.

Devon IT Services will be looking into this and in the meantime we ask that you share a message through your communication networks to alert parents and to ensure they remain vigilant to any unusual calls to them that appear to be made on behalf of their children's school requesting a payment.

PTA Play Equipment for the playground

The Grove School PTA have been asked to consider funding some much needed play equipment for the playground. As some of you are probably aware the children have had many years enjoying the climbing area and rope bridge equipment just opposite the reception class' outdoor area (in between the two outdoor sheds). However, it has now time to retire that equipment and give the area a new lease of life. We are proposing a purpose built outdoor piece of equipment, similar to a low level assault course/climbing structure suitable for all age groups. We are seeking out independent quotes. Although it is difficult to get an exact figure it is looking likely to cost approx, $\pounds 12K$ although this is subject to change and adjustments. Understandably this is a considerable amount of money and so we require the support from the school to proceed with this. The PTA have supported this request and we will continue to help fund smaller projects throughout the year alongside this project.
