Welcome Back

Uniform reminder

We have been, understandably, relaxed about uniform last term but please could you ensure that your children are in correct uniform. Noting particular that if leggings are worn then a skirt should be on top, trousers are more than acceptable for girls but not leggings on their own. Also our school summer dress colours are red/white check or yellow/ white check and our school jumper is not red but burgundy. Shoes/trainers should be dark in colour unless they are sandals which can be any colour as it is hard to get summer shoes in dark colours. Please avoid jewellery except for watches and stud ear-rings.
