Main fundraising target for coming year

Could we do a Survey/ Online Survey to ask parents and staff what they would like to see money spent on, to include if they would like to see Phase 2 of the play equipment go ahead?

Thoughts from committee; would need to fix issues with phase 1 first (slide), would be good to spread the children out along the bank to the other phases as currently used by a lot of children. It is a good visual advertisement for the PTA and what it can provide for the children, also for the public who have been using the car park and seeing the plans for phase 2. More detailed information about what Phase 2 and 3 consist of would be good, for new parents and to get a really clear idea of what is available for the money.
