Covid Update

Currently we have 15 cases, and 9 are in Flame Tree Class, as a consequence of this we will be bubbling up our classes internally to contain any transmission. I'm not sure what official policies are with regard to Lateral Flow as there still seem to be contradictory advice but I would suggest that using a Lateral flow on a child is fine and should give you a quick response. This would be useful if they have a headache and a sickness feeling as many of our cases for children are presenting this way to start. If they have clear COVID symptoms - cough, high temp, loss of taste or smell then follow up a lateral flow with a PCR. Positive lateral flows should also be followed up with a PCR. Always let us know if you have a positive result or are awaiting results. Please be ultra-vigilant.
