The school has been given the opportunity to take part in a project that will run jointly between schools and Devon and Cornwall Police

Dear Parents/Guardians,

I'm pleased to let you know that we will be holding a book fair in school with Vikki Drew from Usborne Books at Home. We will receive up to 60% of the value of all the books sold at the book fair in free books, so for every £1 spent, the school will receive up to 60p to spend on reading books!
