# **VIOLIN LESSONS**

I have space for a few new beginners to start lessons on the violin with me at The Grove School. The lessons happen each week of the school term on Wednesdays, and I invoice by email half termly, payment is made by BACS.

The cost of shared Group Lessons is Group of 3, £5.50 per lesson per pupil, Group of 2, £7.50 per lesson per pupil and an Individual lesson, £15 per pupil

Lessons are 30 minutes each.

The children are collected from their classroom by myself for their lesson.

Group lessons are really fun and a great way to start learning the violin. Rhythm games, improvising using basic percussion as well as learning the technique to play the violin is an essential part of the lessons, and the creativity that they engage in stays with them for the rest of their life. I have a few instruments I am happy to lend out, so you don't need to invest straight away in an instrument.
