# **Young Play Leaders**

19 primary schools attended the first of our series of three young Play Leader conferences of this academic year. On arrival, the children were asked to create a small game with minimal equipment and space. By the time all the schools had arrived we had created the craziness of a small playground bursting with children playing and being active. Pupils shared their ideas bravely in front of each other.

The group were then split into two so they could do two separate workshops. The first workshop explored 'What qualities make a good leader' and then explored these qualities in practical activities. The second workshop gave the Young Play Leaders and their staff member time to do a S.W.O.T. analysis about their current active playtimes. Each of these aspects where really discussed with some fantastic ideas to improve and develop. The children and staff were buzzing with next steps to take back to their schools to develop further.



# **Girls Football Development Day**

On Thursday 28th September over 60 girls took part in a girls only football development evening from 4pm – 6pm. The evening consisted of an hour of skill related activities which the students took part in on a carousel basis. During this first part of the session the students worked on key skills required for football such as passing, dribbling and shooting. The students then competed in a mini world cup format competition where they got to experience small sided matches against their own year groups. All girls showed tremendous energy and enthusiasm throughout!
